



HOW TO REACH US – SITE GÖTTINGEN

By airplane and train

The closest international airport is Hannover Airport (140 km from Göttingen).

At Hannover airport take the rapid-transit railway S5 to Hannover main station (about 15 minutes). From there take an Intercity Express, Intercity or the Regional Express train to Göttingen main station. A cab ride from main station to the Application Center for Plasma and Photonics of the Fraunhofer IST takes about 12 minutes.

Public transportation

At Göttingen main station take

■ Bus 71 or

■ Bus 72 direction Zietenterassen.

The bus stop is on the west side of the station building. Exit at the stop Ehrengard-Schramm-Weg, from there it is a 3 minutes walk to the Application Center for Plasma and Photonics.

By car

From the north

Coming from the freeway A7 exit at junction 73 (Rosdorf/Göttingen/Dransfeld) and turn right onto the B3/Dransfelder Straße. Further see "Göttingen city area".

From the east

Coming from the freeway A38 exit at junction 1 (interchange Dreieck Drammetal) onto the A7. Further see "From the South".

From the south

Coming from the freeway A7 exit at junction 73 (Rosdorf/Göttingen/Dransfeld) and turn right onto the B3/Kasseler Landstraße. Further see "Göttingen city area".

From the west

Coming from the freeway A44 at the exit 70 (interchange Dreieck Kassel-Süd) take the A7, direction Hamburg/Hannover/Kassel. Further see "From the South".

Göttingen city area

Coming from the federal road B3, cross a railway bridge and turn right onto B27/Bürgerstraße. After approximately 1 km, follow the straight lane and take the "Geismar Landstraße", turn left and after

approx. 600 m turn left into the street "Am Steinsgraben". Follow the road for about 2 km, the road is now called "Von-Ossi-etzky-Straße". At the end of the road turn

left to stay on the "Von Ossietzky-Straße". The Application Center for Plasma and Photonics can be found after a few meters on the right (follow signs).
